I suspect you'll find it is probably a "standard" item, in so far as many manufacturers, indeed coachbuilders, would have gone to the same supplier for this product. If you think about it, window glass is undoubtedly a standard thickness. Not saying that makes it easy to source, but you could try trim specialists, also perhaps the people at autojumbles selling rubber mouldings. Probably the same section in my V12 dhc so would be interested to hear if you find something suitable.
