Your first step should be to join the Lagonda Club, if you have not done so already. Then contact Arnold Davey, the Registrar, who will be able to tell you what previous history is on file regarding your particular V12. It is also possible to obtain a copy of the works history, which you will I believe have to pay for, from one of Maurice Leo's sons.

On purchase, you should have received the original UK registration books, or at least the last one before your car left the UK. Sadly such paperwork often gets overlooked at time of sale, especially where, in the USA, it probably had no legal relevance.
