The screen that I used was a Bentley screen where the aero screens doubled as wind deflectors when the screen is up. I got the bare side castings from James E.Pearce Bentley Specialists. They also supplied me with some of the brass rails etc and I made it all up so that it fitted the car. You need to be able to do silver soldering !
