Normally in the nearside spare wheel cover was the hydraulic jacking pump (lever and controls) for operation of the built-in jacks. (see also post "jackall system"). In the offside spare wheel cover was the spare wheel. And the radio was near the batteries in the double bulkhead. I found an image in the huge Holthusen book and some images for the operating front end. It looked a bit different compared to yours but I assume different systems were used.
