There is zero resistance in the pumping action so there is almost certainly no petrol being pumped. When I first got the car 3 years ago you could feel the fuel being pumped after a few pumps but now it just feels empty. I haven't worried too much because the car starts ok.

It's not a complicated thing Richard, but it is a bit fiddly. A few ball bearings, springs, a diaphragm and graphite cord top seal the shaft. I think the piston has a square section o-ring that could need replacing. Once you start stripping it you'll need to persevere though. I have some graphite cord left over from when I did the one on my Aston. You're welcome to it.

I'm by no means an expert but if there's no resistance my guess is that the spring/ball is gummed up and will just need cleaning. I am pretty sure that some vintage tractors used these as well and that you can buy a service kit. aerovintagespares.com used to sell replacements once but I've no idea if they still do.
