Hi Barry,

I think these are original, and I suggest that if you have new ones made up you leave out the Tecalamite fittings and instead bind the springs with grease impregnated tape. In the UK this is called Denso tape (<http://www.denso.net/index.htm>.)

Your nice smart new gaiters then simply cover up the Denso tape and your springs will never need further attention.
