I've made contact with a firm who produce low volume injection mouldings, they are going to copy the lock pin in black plastic.

Plunkett Associates ([See here](#)) will give me a unit price once they have dimensioned off the original.

I think the aluminium option would be too complicated and expensive due to the internal thread and the fact that it would have to be machined. Would those who need this part be happy with a like for like in plastic?

If you are interested please let me know so I can estimate how many to get made - I'm thinking that 50 is probably a minimum run. All to be confirmed.
