Just as a point of interest, the parcel shelf cannot be installed properly with the rear screen in place.

Thanks David, the one I removed used the vinyl folded round to stop vibration - may try the same method. I was thinking earlier (while stripping out bits and pieces) that I will make sure I place lots of felt at pinch points around the interior to avoid squeeks and rattles...

It's been a heck of a job fabricating the new parcel shelf to the exact spec as the original and using all of the original brackets and fittings - I'm on my second attempt already! Fortunately I have a good supply of quality ply of every size and thickness to see me through this restoration...

It may seem odd the way I'm renovating the car but I'm simply restoring parts as they are removed to reduce the risk of me forgetting how things go together and to avoid components going missing...
