The diameter of a cylinder across the top from one side to the other should be approx. 78 mm. This is for the 2.6 litre engine.

if you post a picture with the cylinder head off, I can confirm if this is the correct engine.

You probably know already if you have removed the cylinder head, that the head gasket is copper, and a replacement will be needed and they are reasonably expensive.
