Is this a V12 ? If so, I believe they're identical to the LG45 items. Judging by the screw holes you have they are what you're looking for. I got some for my LG45 from Alan Brown (B99). That said he did only manage to find me 3, so doubt he could find any more. Presumably as you don't know what you need you are missing all four of them? I got a fourth from someone who was using it as a sample to try to make a set. Not an easy job. I think they gave up.

I can measure and/photograph one of mine if that'd help.
